Dual Enrollment, Early Admissions & Accelerated Dual Enrollment

We understand that as a high school student he/she will have an increase in academic study load and will take advantage of the resources at the college such as [Tutoring and Academic Success Center](#) and Library Services.

We understand that as a Public/Private high school student he/she will continue to meet with their high school counselor at least once a semester and stay on track with high school opportunities/academic planning.

We understand that the student is responsible for transportation to/from the college.

We understand that the student is responsible for complying with the SCF (State College of Florida) [Academic Calendar](#). This includes the add/drop and withdrawal deadline.

We understand that as a Public high school student he/she is required to obtain appropriate textbooks and materials from the Instructional Materials Office and/or the high school. Approvals for instructional materials are made by the high school. Students must be prepared on the day of class with required materials.

We understand that as a Private/Homeschool or PEP student he/she must monitor their SCF email for instructions to obtain appropriate textbooks and materials.

We understand that there are no additional tuition or text costs for taking approved fall/spring classes within the program. Specific equipment such as lab coats, goggles and scientific calculators are covered by the student.
